HERE ARE 10 SIMPLE WAYS YOU AND YOUR CONGREGATION CAN GET INVOLVED:

1

Preach about HIV testing and treatment and the healing of HIV/AIDS during your worship service

2

Get tested for HIV yourself, and encourage your congregation to get tested for HIV

3

Include an insert in your church bulletin about HIV/AIDS and where to get tested locally

4

Host an HIV testing and educational event for your congregation and community

5

Hang HIV/AIDS awareness posters in your house of worship

6

Place church fans in your pews that promote HIV testing and awareness

7

Offer special prayers during the worship service for the healing of AIDS

8

Disseminate educational materials to your congregation and to the community during the worship service or other event

9

Commit to developing an HIV/AIDS Ministry in your house of worship

10

Develop support groups for those affected by HIV/AIDS
